It is with great sadness that we inform our bridge friends that Tom Hallum, age 85, passed away. He was born to Cordell and Jenny Hallum who preceded him in death along with his brother Ken.

Tom grew up in Chicago where he shared a close bond with his brothers. Tom was the

eldest, Ken was second, and Jim the youngest. Tom moved to Mishawaka later in life to be with his brother, Jim, but remained committed to spending time with his family and friends.

Tom enjoyed a fulfilling career as a printer for many years and he also served in the National Guard, which he said taught him discipline and the value of teamwork (great traits for the bridge world). These experiences enriched his life and allowed important connections within his community.

He said he couldn't remember when or why he first started playing duplicate but, when he did, he certainly found his niche. He earned the title of Diamond Life Master (5,000+ masterpoints) after receiving many accolades in the past 40 years since he started playing duplicate in Chicago. Tom played a smart, competitive game with great insight but always with humor. He made SBBC a tough place for the rest of us to play and win!He was always available to answer any bridge questions and was a great mentor to many members.
